**RTI and Differentiated Instruction:
How They Work Together**

What should teachers do to meet the needs of all students — from those who struggle academically or behaviorally to our gifted and talented students? How do we know when interventions are working and when they are not? The RTI approach uses research-based interventions and monitors each student’s progress toward success. Differentiation is a way to design curriculum and instruction to meet the needs of each student. These two concepts are a natural pairing in helping teachers meet individual student needs.

In this workshop, learn how to implement a number of practical differentiation strategies. Find ways to accommodate different learning styles and modalities. Understand how to use pre-assessments to determine individual student strengths and weaknesses and formative assessments to assess and monitor the effect of each strategy on individual students. 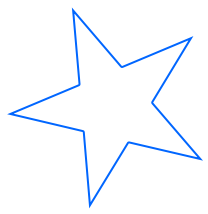
**Breakout Session
