Parking

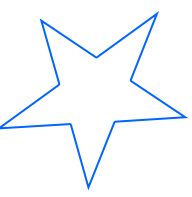

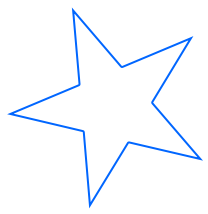

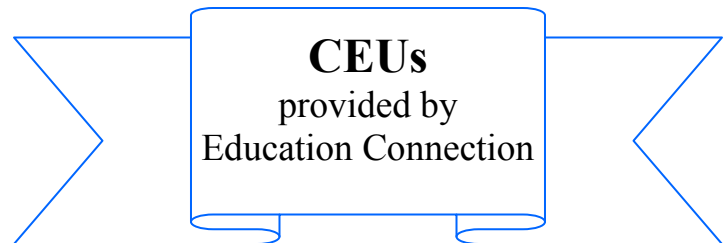
