Differentiating for ELL Students

Nonie Lesaux is the Marie and Max Kargman Associate Professor in Human Development and Urban Education Advancement at the Harvard Graduate School of Education. She leads a research program that focuses on increasing opportunities to learn for students from diverse linguistic, cultural, and economic backgrounds. Her research on reading and vocabulary development, and instructional strategies to prevent reading difficulties has implications for practitioners, researchers, and policymakers.

In 2009, Dr. Lesaux received the Presidential Early Career Awards for Scientists and Engineers, the highest honor given by the United States government to young professionals beginning their independent research careers. A native of Canada, she holds a doctorate in educational psychology and special education from the University of British Columbia.

Dr. Lesaux is a member of IRA's Rtl Commission. She co-authored a chapter titled, Rtl for English Language Learners in the book *Successful Approaches to Rtl*.
